Marking scheme of awarding marks for the structured interview to the appointment Grade 01 officers of the Sri Lanka Teacher Educators' Service to the Posts -2024

01. Seniority

Maximum 50 Marks

The marks are awarded from the date promoted to Grade I for the service period under Grade 1 in Sri Lanka Teacher Educators' Service and the amount of marks given shall be decided in accordance with the Circular No.01/2019 of the Public Service Commission. Thus, the total number marks allocated for the service experience shall be given to an officer who have served the maximum service period and for other officers, marks shall be given for the period of service under Grade-1 proportionately.

02. Additional Educational Qualification :

Maximum 12 Marks

The marks shall be given only for the highest educational qualification from the following except the educational qualifications considered as a basic educational qualification of the recruitment to the Sri Lanka Teacher Educators' Service, for grade promotions or for the 3rd Efficiency Bar of the Sri Lanka Teacher Educators' Service, required for this interview.

Certificates submitted herein should be obtained from a University recognized by the University Grants Commission or from an institution recognized by the University Grants Commission as a degree awarding institution.

Further, the applicants should confirm this in the relevant documents and submit those only at the time of interview. The documents submitted later shall not be accepted.

03. Proficiency of Linking Language:

Maximum 06 Marks

A three minute presentation should be done in English on a randomly selected topic given in relation to the field of education, and the marks shall be given under the following criteria.

04. Information Communication Skill :

Maximum 02 Marks

For a course of 6 months or 720 hours or more in Information Communication Technology / Information Technology - 02 Marks

Further, the marks are awarded for the certificates presented herein only if the duration of the relevant course is mentioned in the Certificate or in the Transcript.

05. Extra-Curricular Activities and Achievements :

Maximum 10 Marks

- I. Certificates of appreciation obtained for the successes in handling the teacher-trainees in at the events of sports / drama / arts festivals or scouting / cadet / Edinburgh or certificates obtained for the innovations made for the betterment of the system of College of Education

[For the certificates issued by the Secretary of the Ministry of Education / Chief Commissioner of Education or by a government affiliated institution or by an international institution recognized by the government (The verified documents should be submitted. In case of any uncertainty emerged during the interview, the final decision is taken about the awarding marks after making inquiries from the relevant institutions)]

Marks are awarded for the maximum of 04 certificates as 02 marks per a certificate

- II. Evaluations of service formally issued by the Secretary of the Ministry of Education or the Head of Department as per the Form General 230 B - Commendations and Censures
- 02 Marks

(Head of Department means the Chief Commissioner – Teacher Education)

Marks are awarded for maximum 2 evaluations as 01 mark per each.

(The service evaluations done for the tasks under above 05.1 are not considered under this)

06. Researches and Publications:

Maximum 15 Marks

a) Researches - 05 Marks

No marks are given for the researches/ dissertation relevant to the dissertation which had already been presented to the Post Graduate Degree/Post Graduate Diploma and Marks are given only for 01 research report that has been presented to a Research Symposium or Research Journal.

- I. Individual Research Report - 05 Marks
II. Group Research Report - 03 Marks

(The meaning of the Research Symposium shall be considered herein as a panel consisting with an academic relevant to the research field and an expert/an academic relevant to the field on which research has been carried out and at least two staff officers.)

(b) Publications - 10 Marks

- I. For a subject related publication issued with International Serial Book Number (ISBN) or International Standard Serial Number (ISSN). (Marks are given only for the books and journals bearing individual authorship)

For a maximum of 01 as 04 marks per one

- II. A chapter of a subject related publication issued with International Serial Book Number (ISBN) or Refereed Journals with authorship. (Individual authorship must be held for the chapter or referred journal)

For a maximum of 02 as 02 marks per one

- III. Abstracts published with authorship or the subject related articles published in newspapers or journals

For a maximum of 02 as 01 mark per one

07. Overall competency shown at the interview:
