This Service Minute shall come into force with effect from 01.07.2020

02. Appointing Authority

Secretary of the Ministry of Education on whom the powers have been delegated by the Public Service Commission.

Twice the number of vacancies according to the order of merit of marks secured by the candidates at the written examination and number of existing vacancies are called for the interview for evaluating eligibility and a practical test will be held for all such candidates by an Examination Board approved by the Secretary. Basic qualifications will be examined at the very same interview for evaluating eligibility.

The candidates who have obtained minimum marks required to pass the practical test will be appointed to the post of Teacher Advisor by the Secretary of the Ministry of Education according to the order of merit of marks secured at the written examination and the interview for evaluating eligibility.

Official language	An officer appointed the service through a language other than an official language should acquire the proficiency in one official language prior to the confirmation in the post.

10. Grade Promotion

- 10.1. Promotion to Class I from Class II of the service
 - 10.1.1. Requirements to be fulfilled
 - I. Should have completed minimum of a ten (10) year period of active service in Class 2 of the service as at the date qualifying for promotion and earned ten (10) salary increments.

- II. Should have passed the first efficiency bar examination on the prescribed date.
- III. Should have demonstrated a performance at satisfactory or higher level during a period of ten (10) years immediately preceding the date of promotion in_accordance with the approved procedure of the performance appraisal.
- IV. No disciplinary punishment has been imposed in terms of the Public Service Commission Circular No. 01/2020.
- V. Should have acquired the proficiency in Link Language.
- VI. Should have acquired the proficiency in other official language or been exempted therefrom.

10.1.2. Method of Promotion

When the officers who have fulfilled qualifications make a request to the Appointing Authority, promotion to Class I will be made with effect from the date on which they fulfil such qualifications after the scrutiny of their qualifications by the Appointing Authority. The form of application is given in Appendix "E".

11. Appointment to the posts

The Secretary of the Ministry of Education, in accordance with the number of posts approved for each province, will release the officers of the Teacher Advisors Service to the posts in the Provincial Public Service with the concurrence of the Provincial Education Authorities. The placement of officers in the Provincial Public Service and making transfers are handled by the Provincial Education Authority.

12. Conditions governing in the service

- 12.1. The apprentice officers recruited to the service following the completion of the induction training conducted in an institution decided by the Secretary of the Ministry of Education should obtain the certificate concerned. Those officers who fail to complete the induction training will be reverted to their former posts or their service will be terminated.
- 12.2. Every officer recruited following an acting period of one year will be confirmed in service subject to the provisions in 12.1 above, the provisions of the Establishments Code and the Procedural Rules of the Public Service Commission.

13. Definitions

- 13.1. "Minute" means the Service Minute of the Sri Lanka Teacher Advisors Service.
- 13.2. "Commission" means the Public Service Commission appointed in terms of the provisions of Article 54 of the Constitution of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka
- 13.3. "Service" means the Sri Lanka Teacher Advisors Service unless specified otherwise.
- 13.4. "Ministry" means the Line Ministry in charge of the general subject of Education
- 13.5. "Provincial Education Authority" means the Provincial Public Service Commission to whom the powers have been delegated by the Provincial Governor or an officer over whom the powers have been delegated by the respective Provincial Governor.

14.

14.1. Absorption to the Grade System

This Service Minute is applicable only to those who are in service as at the effective date thereof. All officers drawing salaries under the Salary Scale of GE-01 or GE-02 on the due date as per the Public Administration Circular No. 02/2006 and Circulars incidental thereto are absorbed subject to the provisions in Section 04 of Chapter VII of the Establishments Code as follows.

The period of service is computed based on the date of appointment to the post of Teacher Advisor. However, there should be no change in the date of salary increment of the officer concerned due to the reason of absorption and the said date should be in force unchanged as the date of salary increment that existed prior to the absorption. Furthermore, the officer concerned should not be placed in the next higher salary step in terms of Section 4.4 of Chapter VII of the Establishments Code on his last drawing salary step being in correspondence with the new salary step in the conversion.

(i) GE-03 – Grade I

- (a) Teachers with an active and satisfactory period of service not less than twenty (20) years in the Sri Lanka Teacher Service and those who have been duly appointed to attend to the duties of the post of Teacher Advisor by the Provincial Director of Education or Secretary of the Provincial Ministry of Education or Provincial Public Service Commission having not less than ten (10) years of service in the said post will be absorbed in to the Grade I of the Teacher Advisors Service.
- (b) The period of service with experience in the post of Teacher Advisor will be reckoned as a period of service in Grade II from the date on which the officers absorbed into Grade I of the Teacher Advisors Service complete an active and satisfactory period of service of twenty (20) years in the Sri Lanka Teachers Service or the date on which they complete the experience in service of ten (10) years on being duly appointed to attend to the duties relating to the post of Teacher Advisor, whichever comes later.

(ii) GE-03 – Grade II

- (a) Teachers who have not completed the qualification in Sub Sections above having not less than ten (10) years of active and satisfactory period of service in the Sri Lanka Teachers Service and who have been duly appointed by the Provincial Director of Education or secretary of Provincial Ministry of Education or Provincial Public Service Commission will be absorbed into Grade II of the Teacher Advisors Service.
- (b) The period of active and satisfactory service with experience in the post of Teacher Advisor will be reckoned as a period of service in Grade II from the date on which the officers absorbed into Grade II of the Teacher Advisors Service have been duly appointed to attend to the duties relating to the post of Teacher Advisors or the date on which they complete an active and satisfactory period of service of ten (10) years in the Sri Lanka Teachers Service, whichever comes later.

14.2. Conditions of absorption

All officers who are absorbed into the Service should complete the first Efficiency Bar Examination stated in 8.1 and the requirement of Link Language stated in 9.1 within a period of five (05) years from the effective date of the Service Minute.

14.3. The teachers who have been duly appointed to attend to duties relating to the post of Teacher Advisor by the Provincial Director of Education or the Secretary of the Provincial Ministry of Education or Chief Provincial Secretary or the Provincial Public Service Commission should express their willingness for absorption subject to the conditions set out in the Service Minute of Teacher Advisors service within a period of six (06) months from the effective date of this Service Minute. The secretary of the Ministry of Education will issue a notice with application to express such willingness subsequent to publishing this Service Minute.

- 15. In addition to the provisions in this Minute, all officers of this Service will be subject to the provisions of the Establishments Code and the Procedural Rules of the Public Service Commission published in the *Gazette Extraordinary* No.1589/30 dated 20.02.2009 of the Democratic Socialist Republic of Sri Lanka.
- 16. Any matter not provide for in this Service Minute shall be decided by the Public Service Commission on the recommendation of the Secretary of the Ministry of Education.

Answers to questions synchronous to short questions in line with following case study areas should be furnished in the accompaniment of collateral concomitance of education curricular alongside the candidate's creative skills based on his practical experiences as a Teacher Advisor, not merely on his theoretical knowledge:

- I. Distinguishing of Management Concepts and Five pronged roles of Education Management,
- II. Processes of Learning, Teaching and Evaluation and Supervision, role of teacher in above process and the importance of education for everybody,
- III. Students with special needs and resolution of practical class room issues,
 - Eg:- Class room management, ways of achieving optimum productivity from minimum of resources,
- IV. Organization and implementation of activities associated with subjects,
- V. Methods of teacher skill evaluation,
- VI. Principles of supervision, ways of supervision, problems confronted and solutions thereto,
- VII. Nature of school curriculum, The manner in which the school can be affiliated by the curriculum and how to bring about professional trend,
- VIII. Approaches to varied education researches, data collection methods and analyses.

- 02.2. Proficiency in related area of subject
 - Application of the methodologies of Learning, Teaching and Evaluation and equipments in the class room will be examined.

- 03.2. A candidate may sit for the examination in one medium of Language of his preference (Change of the medium indicated in the application will not be allowed after indicating it in the application.)

Appendix "B"

Particulars of the Efficiency Bar Examination passable by the officers in Class 2 of the Sri Lanka Teacher Advisors Service

01. Research Thesis

- 1.1. All Teacher Advisors recruited to or absorbed into the service should submit a research paper on a proposal/ issue with relevance to the education development based on their Education Zone / Division/ School to a Committee appointed by the Provincial Director of Education.
- 1.2. The Secretary of the Ministry of Education should prepare and publish the criteria pertaining to the research paper for information of all officers.
- 1.3. The fact that the relevant Teacher Advisor has fulfilled the requirement relating to the research paper will be accepted only after the issuance of a letter of acceptance by a Committee appointed by the Provincial Director of Education following its assessment thereon in accordance with the respective criteria.

 - 1. English 100 marks
- 02. For this question paper, minimum of 40% marks should be obtained for a pass.
