(II) Syllabus

Intelligence Test
Shall consist of multiple-choice questions to test candidate's skills in reasoning, substitution, interpretation, relevance awareness, conversion, problem solving, understanding of cause & effect relationships, prediction, information organization, pattern identification and adherence to instructions.
Comprehension
Shall consist of objective type questions to test candidate's ability in comprehension and skills in communication, summarization, analyzing and creativity.

(II) Syllabus

General Knowledge
Shall comprise of 50 multiple choice and short answer type questions with more emphasis on national education policies, law, reforms and innovations, history of indigenous education and contemporary developments, national and international trends in education, contemporary information in local and foreign education to test candidate's knowledge on science and technology, socio-economic setting, politics, geography, law, environment, culture and sports.
Analytical Studies
Shall comprise of objective type questions prepared based on case studies, tables, graphs and charts to test candidate's skills in analysis, synthesis and creativity.

02. Medium of Examination

- I. This examination will be held in Sinhala, Tamil and English Languages.
- II. Candidates can sit the examination in any one of these languages of their choice.
- III. Candidates should answer all question papers and select only one medium of language for all the papers.
- IV. Candidates will not be allowed to change the medium of examination produced by them in the application form.
- V. The medium of examination selected by the candidate shall also be the medium of recruitment.
